- Interact with children in a positive and enthusiastic manner, encouraging their participation and fostering a love for learning.
- Build strong relationships with parents by providing feedback, answering questions, and creating a supportive community within the classes.

Learning goals

- Explore the basic building blocks of music such as pitch, rhythm, and tempo through group songs, dance, and games.
- Hear, touch, and play different instruments.
- Build relationships within the class community.
